

Student Code of Conduct

This document refers to: The expectations from Nexus ICA that students should abide by.

General

- Students must inform the school in advance if they would like to have visitors during school hours and inform relevant tutors before their arrival to check that it is permissible for the visitor to sit in on any timetabled activity.
- Practise common courtesy at all times in verbal and written communication to staff, faculty members, guests and fellow students.
- Unnecessary noise and interruptions during timetabled activities is not acceptable.
- Please be aware of the neighbours and do not congregate outside the building during breaks. Avoid excessive noise when returning from the shops.
- Proper attire is required when in the building or attending any school activity. This includes the wearing of shoes at all times. Students are representing the school so are asked to dress appropriately.
- All mobile phones must be switched to silent mode during timetabled activities.
- Students may not use school telephones without prior permission.
- Students are not permitted to exclude themselves from any timetabled activities in order to pursue a job and under no circumstances will job commitments be viewed as a mitigating circumstance for absence from any part of the course.

Consumption

Whilst in the Nexus ICA building, students are asked to adhere to the following in order to help keep the building clean and tidy:

- Eating and drinking is allowed only in designated areas. No food or drink is to be consumed in any classes (except vocal classes at the discretion of the vocal tutors).
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted in the building or in the car park. Smoking or vaping by a student is not permitted during school hours or whilst representing the school in any way out of normal school hours.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the building. Anyone found possessing alcohol will face disciplinary procedures.
- Possession of illegal substances is not tolerated at any time. Anyone found in possession of any illegal substance will face disciplinary procedures.
- Students must not bring newspapers, magazines, or DVDs/videos onto the premises that contain material of a sexual or otherwise morally questionable nature.
